PUBLIC BUSINESS

1. Dune Restoration presentation by Cara Abbott, Assistant Director of Programming from the Institute for Regional Conservation.

Ms. Cara Abbott, Assistant Director of Programs for The Institute for Regional Conservation (IRC), gave a presentation about Restoring the Gold Coast (RGC) and the Importance of Diverse Dunes. Ms. Abbott went over the RGC Program, historical ecosystems, dune biodiversity, and the importance of restoring the coastal ecosystem as a defense against climate change and sea level rise.

Ms. Whipple mentioned the County worked with the Town in target areas and planted sea grapes and sea oats. She said the crossovers were being worked on due to intense beach erosion.

Ms. Abbott said those are perfect planting locations to fill in with native plants that overtime naturally capture sand.

Ms. Whipple asked if the information could be passed along to Thomas Hernandez, Director of Engineering and Public Works.

Laura Cahill, Town Clerk, said she would forward to Mr. Hernandez.

Ms. Emily Johnson asked what would a project cost.

Ms. Abbott stated it depended on the scale and current availability of funding.

2. Friends of Jupiter Beach - Quarterly Update.

Mr. Rick Opton, on behalf of Ms. Mary Aguiar for Friends of Jupiter Beach (FJB), gave an update on the current participation levels of the beach cleanups. He mentioned the upcoming FJB Food and Wine Festival fundraiser being held on May 20, 2023.
