III APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

a. October 21, 2024 Minutes: Robin Made a motion to approve MINUTES and Penny seconded. All were in favor, approved.

IV REPORTS:

a. **Financial** - Satu Oksanen attached a G/L Detail to agenda. One additional expense reported, no substantial changes. Total to date expended: \$2179.59. Report attached.

b. **Advertising/Marketing** -Brenda keeping up advertising on Facebook

c. **NPBCA** - NO MEETING UPDATES at this point.

d. **Branding Committee: Elizabeth:** 2025 Centennial Celebrating NEXT YEAR ongoing committees work going well.

V OLD BUSINESS: a. **FALL Show Art Pick Up for 1 day: **December 9th** between 9am and 12noon. Robin volunteered, Dylan and Brenda also said they'd be around and Satu would be available in her office that morning and other times for outliers that couldn't come in that time slot.**

b. Discussion about **POSTER CONTEST** and winner: Poster winner chosen (and they agreed with our feedback on choices-chose the same one we liked) What will be done/displayed with original version of poster? Will their be an unveiling? Promo/PR kits? Need to ask. Should be about "artist" and promo should

include Art Committee. "Publicity Chair" will find out what's going on and take it on. More discussion...

VI: NEW BUSINESS: a. **New Show: NAME** discussed- **Wanted to include and work around the Centennial theme.** Came up with: **"Legacy of Light - 100 Years of Jupiter"**. Brenda made a motion to approve the name, Penny seconded. All were in favor...**APPROVED.** Penny mentioned that she had spoken with someone who had been a Lifeguard back in the day, and that he mentioned there were some artifacts found that will go in the Lighthouse Museum. Penny asked him if he would be interested in being a part of our next show because of the Centennial theme.

The next show opens January 24th, 2025 opening and runs through March 9th. Installation is January 20th and 21st, Pick up on 3/10/25. Elizabeth is sending out the Call to Artists and is adding the caveat for all out regular artists that show, we request art that has NOT previously been displayed in our Gallery of Art.

VII: HARBORSIDE: Per Robin, artists are still in all four cases. One case (Judy Wolfe's) has been changed out and have an artist lined up for another case. Trying to reach Lorrie Williamson and Eric Parker regarding the cases they are in currently. People have been selling their arts and crafts successfully from these cases. Gentleman at Atlantic Fine Art has been unofficially fielding calls and talking to people who drop by his gallery who are inquiring about artists' work in those cases.

VIII: REMARKS & RECOMMENDATIONS: Penny wanted to add mention of including the Utility Wraps Project and Possible Art in the new Fire Department lobbies for future discussions and agendas. Also, that our lists and other data should not be shared with any commercial entities. Dorothy also recommended that "themes for the Centennial include a viewpoint of how Jupiter has evolved over the past hundred years. This could include growth and demographic changes."

IX: DATE AND TIME FOR NEXT MEETING: It was proposed that the Committee take **December off**, but it was discussed that Dylan needed a meeting for end of year and we may as well have a little Holiday Party and white elephant exchange. So we revised our schedule to have a meeting: **Next Meeting, December 16, 2024 at 6:00pm...there will be food.** Brenda made a motion to approve budget \$200, Elizabeth seconded.
